

Carlock Award Application

Graduate students pursuing a Master's or Ph.D. in a biological science field who intend to teach college biology after they earn their degree are encouraged to apply for grants through ACUBE from the Carlock Award Fund. This award pays for all meeting expenses (hotel, food and student meeting registration fee) up to \$250 per meeting. Travel expenses are not included. Individual are expected to travel with a current ACUBE member to the meeting. Graduate students are encouraged to present a poster or a talk at the meeting but this is not a requirement to receive an award. A maximum of two awards will be given each year.
