White Pine Hollow is a 700 acre white pine relic stand about 25 miles west of Dubuque. It is a state preserve and is on the Federal Registry of Natural History Landmarks. It is the southwesternmost natural white pine stand in the United States.

The Loras seismograph, constructed in 1961, is the only operating seismograph station in Iowa. It provides data for the National Earthquake Information Service.

TO THE ANNUAL MEETING

The Steering Committee in accordance with the Constitution (Article VIII, Section 2) submits the following changes to the membership for their consideration. Voting will be done during the annual meeting at Loras College, Dubuque.

ARTICLE IV Officers and Their Election

Section 1. Change the last sentence of this paragraph to read as follows: "The Steering Committee shall appoint an executive secretary and an editor, both of whom shall be ex-officio members of the Steering Committee."

Section 5. Change "simple majority" in first sentence of this paragraph to "plurality", as the basis for election of officers.

By-Laws, ARTICLE I Terms and Duties of Officers

Section 1. Delete the third sentence from this paragraph. "The election for secretary shall be held in odd numbered years."

Section 8. Delete the phrase "publication and distribution of such journals and other informational papers as directed by the Steering Committee;" which is found in the second sentence.

Section 11. This is a new section to be added to ARTICLE I. "The editor will serve an indefinite term under mutual agreement between the editor and the Steering Committee. The duties of the editor will be to publish and distribute the journal of the Association and other informational papers as directed by the Steering Committee."
